



# Grassroots Grants

## Swindon Borough Council

Grassroots grants are for smaller organisations (those with less than £50,000/year income, with a management group, governing document and a bank account). They may bid for up to £1000 per year, for 'one-off' items rather than ongoing expenditure. Grassroots grants may go towards equipment, improvements to buildings, support to festivals, and other events, projects, or activities. The priority categories for 2010/11 are:

- 1. Community festivals** – festivals and celebrations in local neighbourhoods or that celebrate the diversity of local communities.
- 2. Environmental sustainability** – consideration will be given to projects or activities from community and voluntary organisations.
- 3. Discretionary grants** – aiming to improve the social, economic and environmental well-being of Swindon.
